

The eMedia Resources Book

The eMedia team, part of the Office of eLearning at the South Carolina Department of Education, works closely with South Carolina ETV to provide instructional resources and services to South Carolina public schools. eMedia is responsible for the selection of resources, the development of local programming to support our K-12 curriculum and the scheduling of the approved resources. ETV provides expert production and technical delivery services to support instructional programming.

Special notes on the 2011-2012 eMedia Resources book:

- **Information in the eMedia Resources book** includes lesson titles, catalog numbers and lesson lengths for the block fee programs (see below), and the lesson titles, lengths, and catalog numbers for the “By Request” series (also see below).
- **If a series title does NOT appear in this book in Sections II or III, the series has been removed.** It is a violation of copyright to use these deleted resources, unless retention rights are arranged with the vendor. See page 4.
- **ALL SERIES ARE BLOCK FED.** Like last year, most series will ONLY be available via block feeds. We have discontinued the weekly feeds with the exception of programs such as **Teen Kids News**. This block feed schedule will continue to be announced in the monthly *eMedia Update* and will be reflected in the online schedule which can be found on the eMedia Web site at **www.eMedia.scetv.org**.
- **Broadcast Resources Available Online.** More than 1,600 eMedia and ETV broadcast resources are also available in *StreamlineSC*. These are marked with “**SL**” in the Curriculum Overview and the Alphabetical Description.
- **The revised indication, REV,** can mean several things: totally new programs produced for this year, new programs added to the existing series, re-edited, or captioned programs.
- Unless otherwise noted, **all programs in a series indicated by [CC] to the right of the title are closed-captioned.** Programs that are revised with captioning are announced in the monthly *eMedia Update*.
- The **IMPORTANT rights statement** for each resource is located just below the series description. It is a violation of copyright to dub programs that do not have duplication rights.
- **Teacher Guides** may be downloaded as a PDF file from our website **www.eMedia.scetv.org/guides**. *StreamlineSC* also has teacher guides associated with many titles.
- **Teleconferences and electronic field trips** are included in Section II. Please note that these programs are usually provided LIVE, so they do not go through the review process. Also, teacher guide materials are provided, if available, only on the announced Web site.
