

SC2 – South Carolina Self Control

Developed in collaboration with the State Department of Education's Guidance Services, this series of seven instructional television programs was produced by ITV and ETV to provide schools with an effective way to meet the requirements of the Safe School Climate Act. Dr. Sue Smith-Rex, educator and author, developed the content and serves as instructor for the bullying prevention model. The SC2 model was piloted at Geiger Elementary School in Fairfield County. Their participation was key to the production of the video series. The SC2 model consists of three levels. These are outlined in the video lessons and online packet of information that guides educators on how to facilitate the model with their elementary students. The programs show Dr. Sue Smith-Rex teaching and working with students in all three levels while utilizing the key materials in the packet.
