

SC-Alt Test Administration Training (2011)

The South Carolina Alternate Assessment (SC-Alt) Test Administration Training is designed for test administrators (teachers) who are experienced with administering the SC-Alt. The video is to be used in conjunction with district level training conducted by the District Test Coordinator for Alternate Assessment to update test administrators about new features and procedures.

SC-Alt is an assessment for students with significant cognitive disabilities who are unable to participate in the general state assessment, even with appropriate accommodations. The assessment consists of a series of performance tasks and is scored by the teacher as it is administered. All test administrators are required to participate in training prior to administering the assessment.
