The ***Essential Science for Teachers: Earth and Space Science*** self paced course is designed around Annenberg/CPB Professional Development Workshops. Providing participants with fundamental science concepts, these eight one-hour video lessons show demonstrations, still graphics, animation, and real world examples - all designed to correlate with interviews with educated scientists and children about science class topics. These topics range from soil to the solar system. Opportunities are available for increasing students' science knowledge and observing teachers engaging their students in essential observation and research techniques.

All class meetings will take place through distance learning. The instructor and participants will communicate via Moodle — the course platform on the Internet. Assignments and discussion forums will be facilitated in Moodle.
